*Billy Kent Hoover was born on January 11, 1937 to Jasper Earnest & Lizzie Belle [Brock] Hoover near Elmwood, OK. He was the 8th child of 11 children.*

*As a young boy he attended church camp with the First Baptist Church at Gibson Baptist Assembly near Hardesty, OK. Kent made his profession of faith while at camp around the age of 8. He was an active member of the First Baptist Church of Beaver during his youth.*

*Kent attended Beaver Public school and graduated with the class of 1956. He had fond memories of attending school in Beaver. He often talked about playing football, basketball and running track. He told about moving from the school building on Avenue G to the current location. He told about running mile at the State Track meet.*

*Following High School graduation Kent moved to Boulder Colorado to attend the University of Colorado. He attended for one year. He was drafted into the army in 1959.*

*Kent's greatest joy was spending time with his family, kids and grandkids. He involved them in every area of his life and encouraged them in theirs.*
